- 2) Rabies vaccination certificate valid through **October 31, 2019** (if not already on file)
- 3) Stamped self addressed envelope.
- 4) Fee as follows:

**Dogs: Spayed or neutered - \$12.00      Unaltered - \$20.00**  
**Cats: \$8.00 for all cats**

**(Checks made payable to: 'Borough of Bloomingdale')**

Once application is processed, a receipt, animal tag and all documents received with the application will be mailed back to you.
