There were **164 new** presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 in Passaic County.

There were **4 deaths** reported today in Passaic County, one from the City of Passaic, the other 3 were from the Borough of Wanaque.

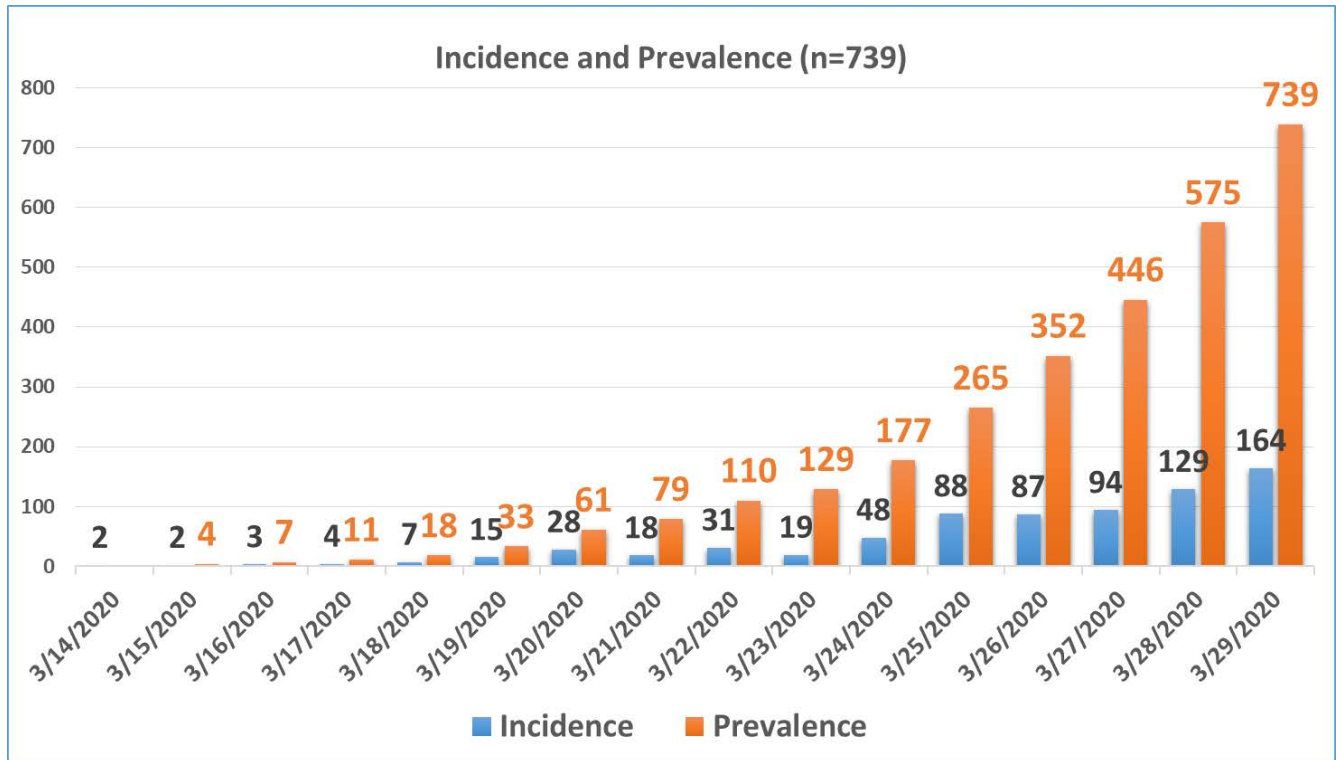
Yesterday's death from Ringwood was that of a 77-year-old Female. She died on 3/27, reported on 3/28 report. Her husband had died on 3/24.

The **COVID-19 testing** site at William Paterson University continues to serve all residents of Passaic County, who present a valid prescription. We were closed on Sunday and will reopen on Monday, March 30, from 9am until 12 noon. The total number of Passaic County residents who were tested so far are **709**.

We will continue to provide testing service to Passaic County residents as long as we have kits, and there is a demonstrated need. CWG

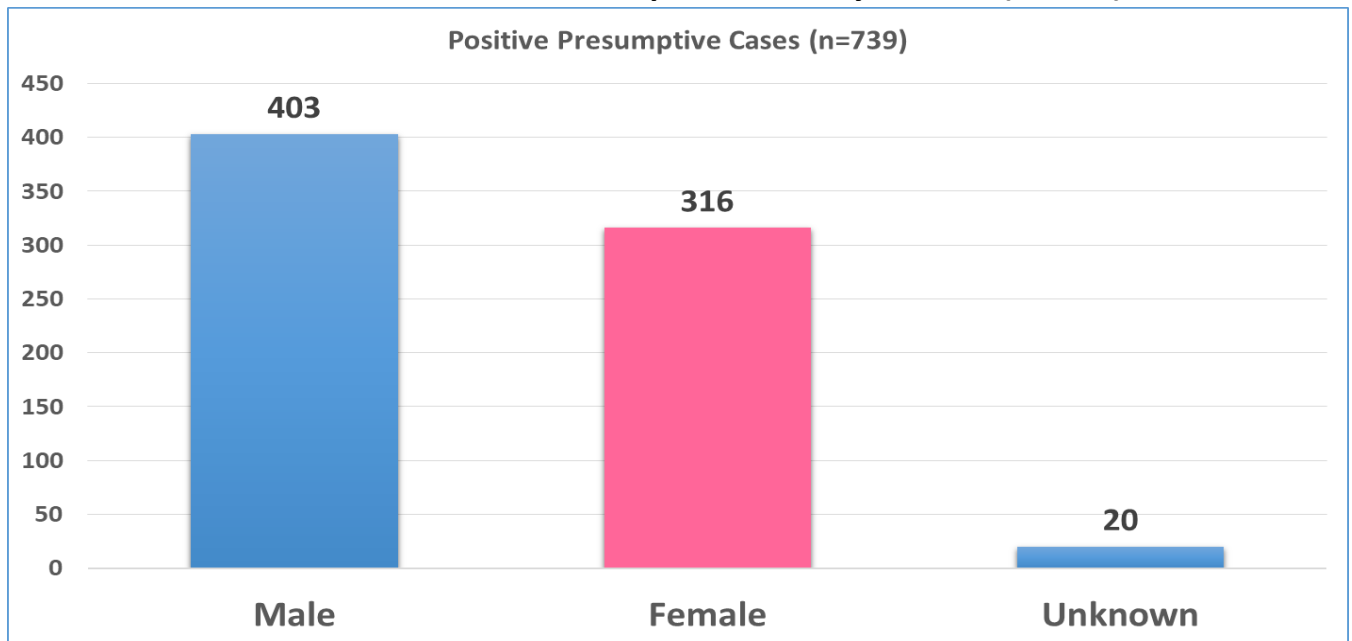

(N=739)**



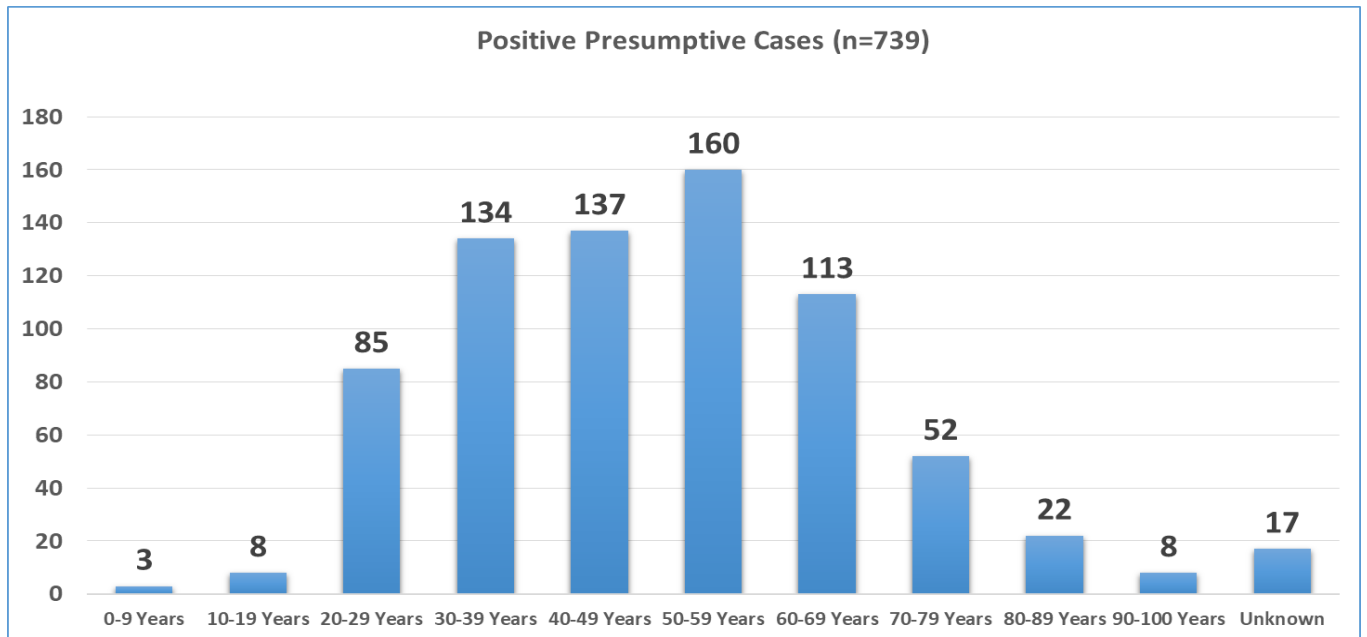

Total Number of Positive Presumptive Cases by Gender (N=739)



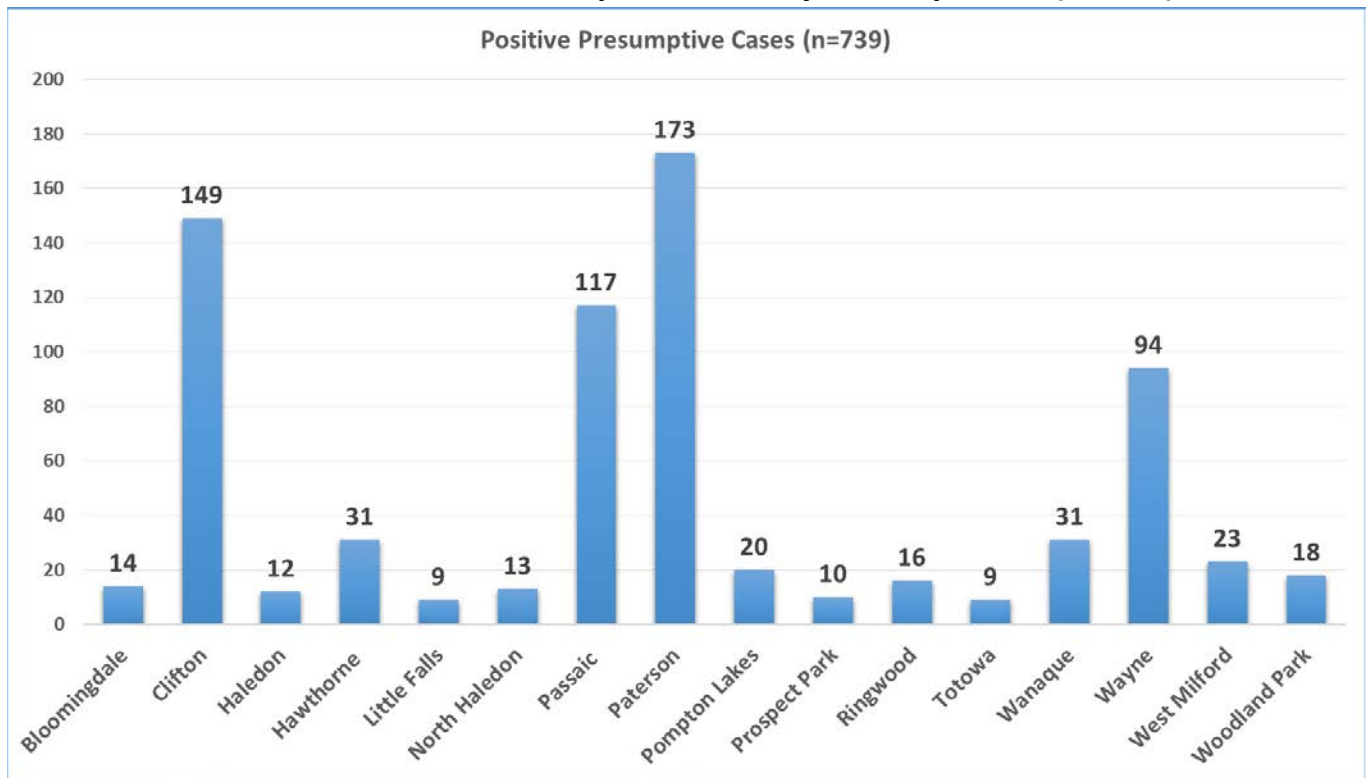

Total Number of Positive Presumptive Cases by Age Range (N=739)

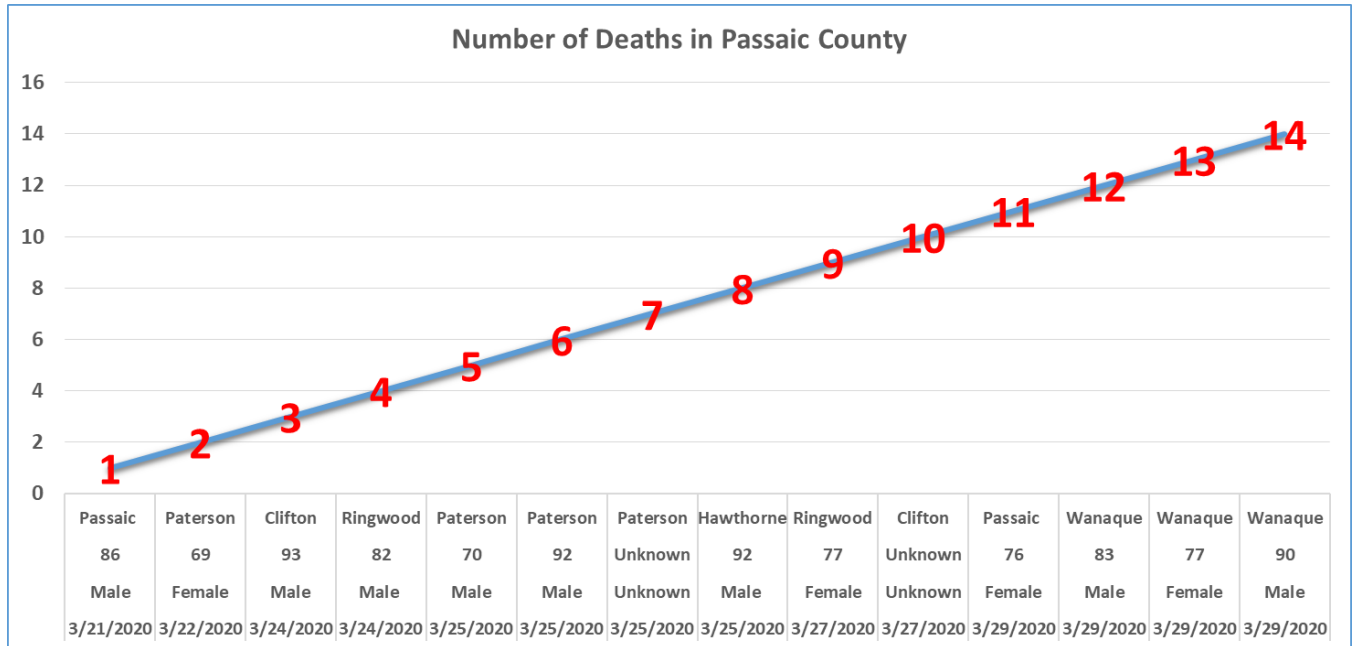

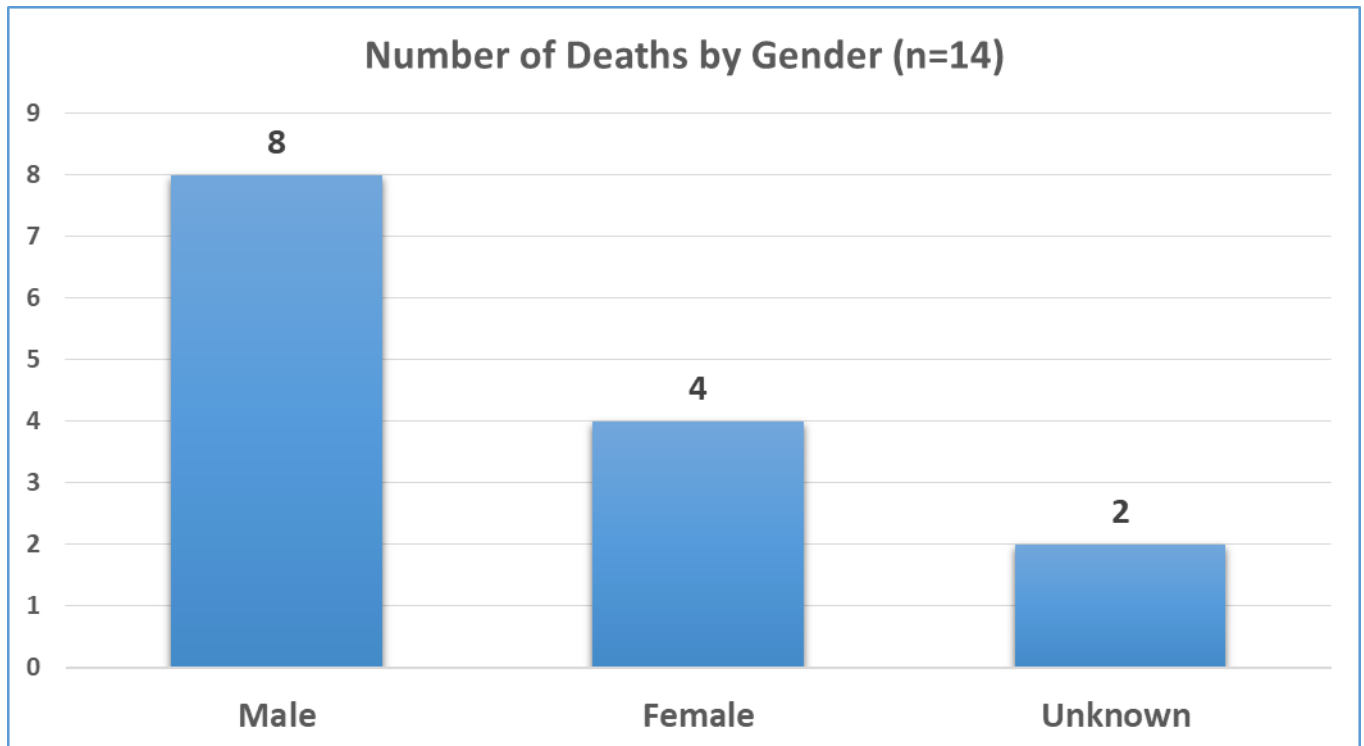
Total Number of Positive Presumptive Cases by Municipalities (N=739)



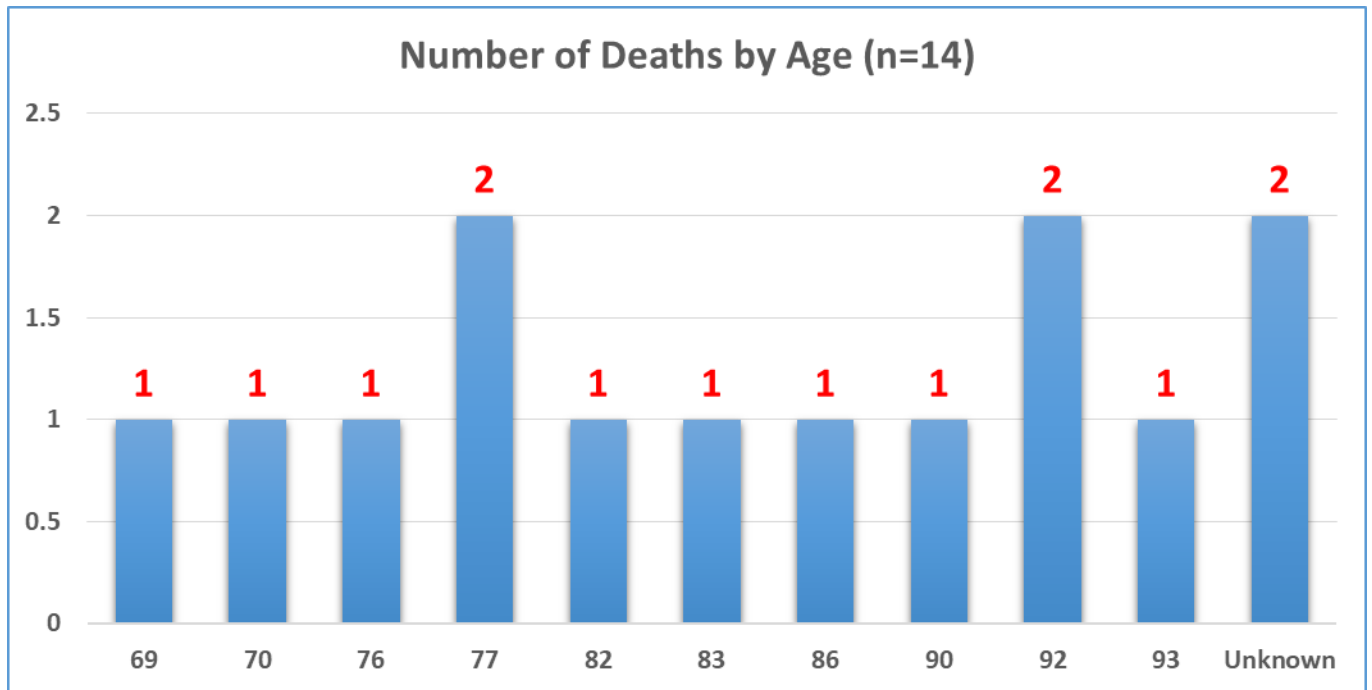
