THERE IS NO RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR ANY CLINIC SITE. All clinic locations are open to all, and vaccinations will be **FREE of CHARGE** and available to all residents who are in the following priority groups:

- pregnant women
- people who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age
- healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- persons between the ages of 6 months and 24 years old
- people ages of 25 through 64 years of age who are at higher risk for 2009 H1N1 because of chronic health disorders or compromised immune systems.

**NOTE: Children ages 9 and under must receive two (2) vaccines, a minimum of 30 days apart in order to be protected from this virus. Please plan accordingly.**
