REGULAR MEETING MINUTES – May 9, 2016

I. Call to Order.

II. Rory Lovelace called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m.

III. Roll Call.

IV. Approval of Minutes April 4, 2016.

Motion was made by Ms. Carney to approve the April 4, 2016 minutes as presented. This motion was seconded by Ms. Tierney and was unanimously approved.

V. Acceptance of Reports

After discussion of the presented reports on motion by Ms. Innamorato with a second by Ms. Peterson the Health Department monthly reports were approved as submitted. On motion by Ms. Carney with a second from Ms. Peterson the retail food summary report was approved as submitted.

VI. Unfinished Business

- A. Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) - The Sr. REHS reported that Peter Correale, H.O. and Sue DeGraw, PHN are on the Heroin Committee. The group is meeting routinely and hopes to complete its plan by July 1, 2016.
- B. Accreditation – The Sr. REHS updated the Board on the Open Forum for QI in Public Health. The attachment to the monthly report with March and April accreditation updates were reviewed by the Board.
- C. Mayor’s Wellness Campaign – Ms. Innamorato and Ms. Peterson would like Pete to reach out to the Mayor to let him know that they are interested in being a part of this campaign. Ms. Tierney said that she looked into Walking with the Mayor and she will continue to follow up on that. She said that it will take a great deal of work in coordinating (police, town, where, what and when)
- D. Poison Control Poster Contest – The Sr. REHS informed the Board that the posters were just recently picked up by the health educator. The health educator would like to have the judging take place this week. Ms. Petersen and Ms. Innamorato may be available tomorrow afternoon to help judge the posters.

VII. New Business

- A. Asthma Seminar – The Sr. REHS informed the Board that Amerigroup offers free health education workshops. The Board may have an interest in offering an Asthma Workshop for residents. The Board was given the flier

from Amerigroup listing all of the workshop topics that are offered for their review. Programs of interest can be scheduled in the future for residents.

- B. Senior Open House – The Sr. REHS reported that the open house was well attended. Ms. Tierney reported that there were 125 attendees. The PHNs were available for blood pressure screenings during the open house.
- C. Public School Water Testing – Lead – The Sr. REHS reported that the Bloomingdale Schools had a private consulting firm test the water in the schools for lead. One faucet came up high at Walter T. Bergen School. The faucet was replaced and will be resampled.
- D. GI outbreak at Martha B. Day School – The Sr. REHS reported that there is a current GI outbreak at Martha B. Day School. A total of 41 individuals affected-28 students and 13 staff. Cleaning protocols have been increased and NJDOH epidemiologist has been notified
