1. This completed animal license application form – *one per animal*
2. **Rabies vaccination certificate valid through October 31, 2026** (if not already on file)
3. Stamped, self-addressed envelope
4. Fee as follows:

Dogs: Spayed or Neutered - \$12.00

Dogs Unaltered - \$20.00

Cats - \$8.00

We accept cash, money orders and checks made payable to “Borough of Bloomingdale”.

Once your application is processed, a receipt, animal tag and any documents you submitted will be mailed back to you.
