PASSAIC COUNTY CLERK DANIELLE IRELAND-IMHOF SHARES INFORMATION FOR VOTERS AHEAD OF THE NOVEMBER 4, 2025, GENERAL ELECTION

Passaic County Clerk Danielle Ireland-Imhof is encouraging voters to prepare for the upcoming General Election on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, by making a voting plan that fits their needs.

Sample Ballots Now Available

Voters can view their sample ballot by visiting www.passaiccountyvotes.org and clicking on "Voters" > "Sample Ballots". Sample ballots will be mailed to all registered voters, in accordance with state law. These include your assigned polling location for November 4, 2025, information and the schedule for all 10 early voting sites across Passaic County.

In-Person Early Voting: October 25-November 2, 2025

Voters can vote at any of the County's 10 early voting locations from Saturday, October 25 through Sunday, November 2. This option allows registered voters to cast their ballot, using a voting machine, prior to Election Day. Early voting locations are listed on the sample ballots and at www.passaiccountyvotes.org.

Voting by Mail

Voters who received a mail-in ballot should follow the instructions included with the ballot on how to complete and return it to the Passaic County Board of Elections. Voted mail-in ballots must be returned or postmarked no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 4, 2025. Voters who wish to obtain a mail-in ballot can visit the Passaic County Clerk's Office in Paterson or Wanaque on weekdays from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., on Saturday November 1, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., and Monday, November 3, 2025, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
