- October 2021 Minutes Approved
- Treasurer Report
  - o Elisa Kolenut has requested 2022 EDC Budget
- Main Street Banners
  - o 14 of 15 possible banners have been sold by Elisa Kolenut to local businesses
  - o Banners will be hung in the spring down Main Street
- Second Friday's Summer Concert Series in Sloan Park
  - EDC to help with planning of Second Friday's Concert Series for 2022
  - Commission agreed it might be best to run in the spring and fall and pause for the summer
