Paterson, NJ - Passaic County Clerk Danielle Ireland-Imhof announces a special **Passport Day “Back to School” event on Thursday, September 3, 2026, from 8:30 a.m. - 7 p.m.**, offering families a convenient opportunity to apply for a new passport as the new school year gets underway.

The County Clerk’s Office will process new passport applications at both the Paterson Main Office, 401 Grand Street, Room 130, and the County Clerk’s Wanaque Satellite Office, 1237 Ringwood Avenue. As a special addition to the event, minor passport applicants will have their passport photo fee waived and receive a complimentary school-supply kit and complimentary ice cream voucher, while supplies last.

“The start of a new school year is a busy time for families, and we want to make accessing our services as convenient as possible,” said County Clerk Danielle Ireland-Imhof. “Our extended evening hours give parents an opportunity to take care of their family’s passport needs outside of the traditional workday, and we’re excited to make the event a little more special for our youngest visitors with back-to-school supplies and a sweet treat.”
